New Members Join the Northern Virginia Regional Commission

Six local government elected officials have become new members of the Northern Virginia Regional Commission. Due to changes in the membership of the governing boards from three counties following last year's election, the makeup of the Northern Virginia Regional Commission has also changed.

New members are: John Foust and Patrick Herrity, from the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors; Lori Waters and Scott York, from the Loudoun County Board of Supervisors; and Michael May and Frank Principi, from the Prince William Board of County Supervisors.

The Northern Virginia Regional Commission is a coalition of local governments that work together on regional issues including environmental and land use, human services, legislative analysis, and emergency planning. NVRC is composed of a 25-member Board of Commissioners who are elected officials appointed by the governing bodies of NVRC's 14 member localities. The local government members are the Counties of Arlington, Fairfax, Loudoun and Prince William; the Cities of Alexandria, Fairfax, Falls Church, Manassas and Manassas Park; and the Towns of Dumfries, Herndon, Leesburg, Purcellville and Vienna.
