AUTHORIZATION TO APPLY FOR TWO-YEAR FUNDING WITH THE NORTHERN VIRGINIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TO CONTINUE MILITARY-FOCUSED TDM PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Northern Virginia Regional Commission (NVRC) received funding from the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission (NVTC) to provide Transportation Demand Management services to personnel working on the military facilities and installations in Northern Virginia; and

WHEREAS, NVRC has established agreements for cooperation and collaboration with the major military installations in Northern Virginia: Marine Corps Base Quantico, Fort Belvoir and Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall, as a result of the work for the Commission's Military, Community and Federal Facilities Partnership Committee; and

WHEREAS, NVTC has a call for projects for the Commuter Choice on the I-395/95 Corridor and the upcoming Round Two (FY 2022-FY 2023); and

WHEREAS, NVRC will be submitting applications for two projects during this call for projects; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; the Executive Director is authorized to submit, and sign said applications regarding the call for projects: Grant proposal #1: Military/DOD employee commuter transit resource program. Requested funding over 2 years: \$692,442. Grant proposal #2: Bikeshare expansion to Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall. Requested funding over 2 years: \$794,414, for a total of \$1,486,856.
