AUTHORIZATION TO APPLY FOR OEA FUNDS FOR COMMUNITY PLANNING ASSISTANCE AND ECONOMIC DIVERSIFICATION IN RESPONSE TO REDUCTIONS IN DOD SPENDING

WHEREAS, the Northern Virginia Regional Commission is involved in coordinating a regional response to the 2005 Base Re-Alignment and Closure (BRAC); and

WHEREAS, as a growing community, Northern Virginia has identified the need to provide an economic analysis of the region that builds on the state findings on procurement; and

WHEREAS, an analysis by military installation procurement and payroll will complete the picture for the region; and

WHEREAS, grant funding would cover staff time for data collection procurement, to organize the community, and to support the Northern Virginia Regional Community, Military and Federal Facilities Alliance; and

WHEREAS, this program may provide a regional perspective of how to diversify our economy, prepare for future workforce issues, and address the impacts of DOD reductions on the region, the communities, workers, and businesses;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Director is authorized to apply to DOD/OEA for up to \$500,000 for the cost of this program to help with the transition of the communities, businesses, and workers in the region;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, should the funding agreement be reached, the Executive Director is further authorized execute an agreement with DOD/OEA to fulfill the requirements of the project, and to amend the Commission's budget and work plan accordingly.
